Roger Emmett taught for 22 years in Staffordshire and was Head of Humanities at Blake High School in Hednesford before he became Adviser for History and Citizenship with Staffordshire LEA in 2002. He became an independent adviser in 2012 and has since worked with schools in Staffordshire, Wolverhampton, Dudley and Warwickshire. Roger is currently also working with Birmingham City University as History tutor for their Teach First programme.



Annette Fisher is a practicing teacher with twenty five years' experience. She was awarded AST status before being employed by the School Improvement Division in Staffordshire. During her seven years there she was responsible for advising on Primary History, Primary Gifted and Talented and Personalised Learning. Since leaving Staffordshire Local Authority she has worked as a Freelance Adviser and Associate Consultant with Education Central Multi Academies Trust. She continues to offer bespoke support for schools and colleagues across the West Midlands. More recently Annette has also returned to a part time primary teaching role.
