5 Sep 55	Displayed in Static Park at SBAC Farnborough display, Hants. Photos on pre-Farnborough sortie; Flypast Jun 1996 p.42; Javelin-Service History (003771) p.27; Aeroplane Monthly Jun 98 p.65; Flypast Mar 1999 p.66-67.
30 Sep 55	Awaiting collection from Glosters.
14 Oct 55	From Moreton Valance to Bristol Aeroplane Co. at Filton, (Bristol), Somerset for Bristol Olympus engine development (intended to power the Gloster P.370 'thin-wing' Javelin, and other trials.
10 May 57	Released from trials work following cancellation of the P.370.
16 Jul 57	To RAF Locking, Somerset for Ground Instructional use with No.1 Radio School/Aircraft Apprentice Training School. Kept in a hangar at the far end of Weston Super Mare Airfield one mile to the west of Locking.
30 Jul 57	Allocated instructional serial 7464M.
4 Apr 67	To No.2 School of Technical Training at RAF Cosford, Salop. By 1968 four Javelins were in use for ground training at Cosford.
Sep 75	Earmarked for the RAF Museum and transferred to the Aerospace Museum at Cosford, where it remained on external display until 2004. Photos; Aeroplane January 2004 p.78; Aeroplane Museums Guide 2004 p.M.38.
Nov 2004	Undergoing restoration in the Michael Beetham Conservation Centre, RAFM Cosford. Photo- Flypast January 2005 p.4.
