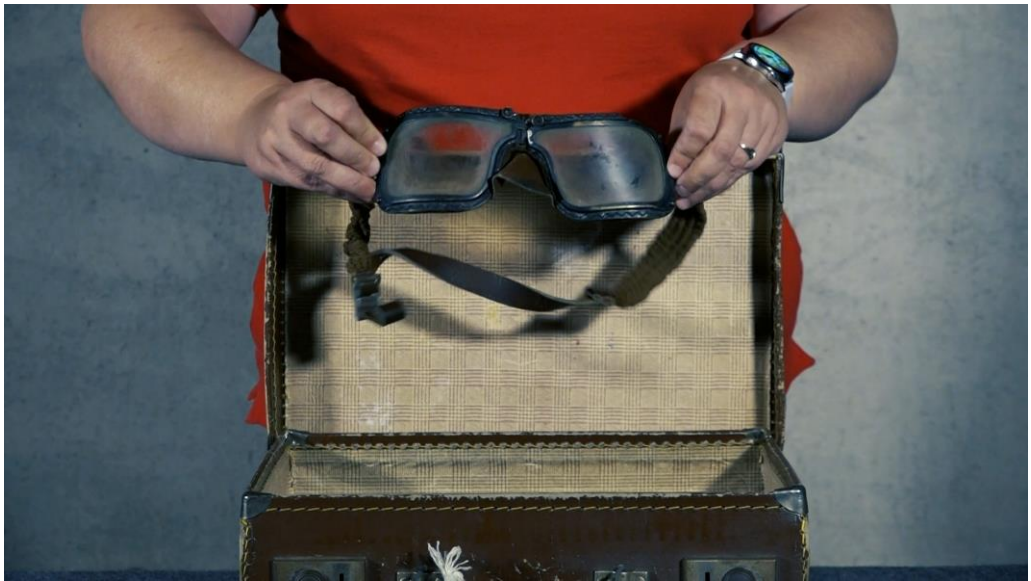

# Learning @ Home Discovery Cases

## Activity 2 – Think and Plan

For you to finish the story, use what you already know, the artefacts you have seen, and most importantly your imagination. You can use our storyboard to map out what you already know, and what you think happens next.

<b>Introduction</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Introduce the main characters</li><li>• Introduce the setting</li></ul>	
<b>Build Up</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Develop the story</li><li>• Events that lead to the climax</li></ul>	
<b>Climax</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The climax of the story – could be left as a cliff-hanger</li><li>• Where are our main characters? How are they reacting?</li></ul>	
<b>Resolution</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• How is the climax resolved?</li><li>• Do we have a happy or sad ending?</li></ul>
