Activity 1 - Think

Look at the picture 'Hendon on a Windy Day' (Hendon is in London and is where you will find the RAF Museum, London).

- What do you think is happening in the picture?
- What are the people trying to do?
- Why is the man lying on the ground?
- What might they do next?
- Do you think they gave up or did they keep trying?



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Activity 2 - Explore
