

Terms & Conditions for the Spitfire Scramble Obstacle course

By purchasing tickets to the Spitfire Scramble Obstacle course, you agree to the following:

1. As a race entrant and/or Spectator you understand that you will adhere to the Rules set out by the organisers of the event. Failure to adhere to the rules may mean disqualification and/or expulsion from the event. You agree to follow the rules set out, which also may change with no notice on the day and adhere to the organisers and their appointed representatives, guidance.
2. By registering for Spitfire Scramble as a racer and/or spectator I confirm the information I provide is true and accurate and that I am who I say I am. As a racer I understand that I am not to give my ticket / place to another without doing the formal online transfer process or giving written consent to race administration.
3. All participants on the main obstacle course are over the age of 8 years old, those under the age of 8 will need to do the mini-course.
4. I understand that the nature of the event is to test a person's mental and physical limits and carries the risk of harm and serious injury. Minor injuries are common (cuts, scrapes and bruising) and the risk of more serious injury (such as broken bones)
5. All those that part take in the Spitfire Scramble Obstacle course that are under the age of 11 must be accompanied by an adult who is charged with their care. If the adult is unable to take part in the course, then they can accompany them around the course without taking part. You will not be allowed to leave your child unattended.
6. All participants take part at their own risk and will not hold the RAF Museum responsible for any injury, sickness or loss as a result of my taking part. You assume all of the risks of participating in this event and accept complete responsibility for any injury or accident which may occur while I am traveling to or from the event, during the event, or while I am on the premises of the event.
7. Small aspects of the Obstacle course may involve you getting a wet, please ensure any previous cuts, scratches or sores are covered with a waterproof plaster before the event.
8. The course involves climbing, crawling and being active. Please ensure you have the correct clothing and foot ware for the course. If you do not, you may not be able to take part. We advise:
 - Flat lace-up or Velcro shoes - no flip flops or heels
 - Clothes you can move in and don't mind getting dusty or wet

9. The course directors and their official representative's judgment is final with reference to the Obstacle course: positioning decisions, conduct, disqualification, places, prizes and any other matter effecting the smooth running of the event.

10. The RAF Museum reserves the right to change or modify the dates, timing, start times, prizes, fees, race rules, number / type / size of groups and any other event details, policies, website content it sees fit, with no prior or advanced notice required.

11. The main website for this event is updated regularly. It is advised that you check here for any new developments and information updates, you cannot solely rely on information you see when first registered.

12. While you are taking part in the event:

- avoid swallowing and/or splashing water into your mouth.
- observe event safety brief and information signs.
- none of the obstacles are compulsory, if you are unsure or want to avoid the risk of illness there is always an alternative route you can use. There will be staff on hand to provide support on the course if required.

13. When you finish and after the event:

- ensure you clean and sanitize your hands thoroughly after the event and before handling/eating food.
- thoroughly clean cuts or abrasions using soap and water.

COVID Health and Safety

- Each session will have a capped capacity to ensure that social distancing and minimum interaction can occur on the course.
- Sanitation points will be located across the Museum and near the start line for you to use before and after the Course if you wish too.
- We advise that if you are positive with COVID or have any COVID related symptoms (including high temperature, a new, continuous cough, headache and a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste) to not participate in the Spitfire Scramble Obstacle Course. We will be more than happy to transfer your ticket to another date if this occurs.

Accident Waiver, assumption of risk, release of liability and indemnity agreement - all participants AARI agreement.

I acknowledge that this AARI agreement will be used and any of its associates for the Spitfire Scramble event in which I choose to participate in and it will govern my actions and responsibilities at the event. In consideration of my application and permitting me to participate in this event, I hereby take action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns as follows:

(A) Waive, release, and discharge from any and all liability for my death, disability personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to me or my traveling to and from this event, The following entities and/or persons; and its affiliates and their respective directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, insurers, spectators, equipment suppliers, and volunteers; RAF Museum and its directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, insurers, equipment suppliers, and volunteers; all event sponsors, organisers, promoters, directors, officials, property owners, and advertisers; governmental bodies and/or municipal agencies whose property and/or personnel are used; and any or all parent, subsidiary or affiliate companies, licensees, officers, directors, partners, board members, supervisors, insurers, agents, equipment suppliers, and representatives of any of the foregoing.

(B) indemnify and hold harmless all entities or persons mentioned in this paragraph from any and all liabilities or claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of my actions during this event.

Waive, Release and discharging Parties are together my spouse, children, parents, guardians, heirs, next of kin, and any legal or personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, or anyone else bringing a Claim against or the Released Parties on my behalf.

I hereby consent to receive medical treatment that may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident, and/or illness during this event.

I agree for the use of Water. I understand that at this event and related activities that participants and spectators will be photographed and filmed. I agree to allow mine and any minors in my charge and care that I bring to the event, that our photo, video, or film likeness to be used for any purpose by the event holders, producers, sponsors, organizers, and/or assigns.

This AARI shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under the applicable law. If any provision of this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, then such provision shall be disregarded and the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

Venue and Jurisdiction I understand that if legal action is brought in connection with this Agreement or its subject matter, the courts of England and Wales shall have the sole and exclusive jurisdiction over the action and that only the substantive laws of England and Wales shall apply.
