Here are some Percy-themed ideas for you:

- Make your own lucky mascot to help keep your spirits up (or perhaps you already have one). You could make one out of many different materials – wool, paper, card, playdough etc.
- Make up a story about Percy – it could be about what happened during the Second World War or he could go on any kind of adventure! You could write your story down, record it, act it out, make a Percy puppet (draw a picture and stick it to a straw, spoon, lolly stick etc) and perform a puppet show – there are loads of ways to share your story!
- Create your own toy museum in your home. Write captions for each toy telling other people about them – you might include information about where you got them from, any special adventures they have had or reasons why they are special to you.
