During your visit

- Explore the Museum to find examples of how we remember events and people.

After your visit

- Use the poppy that was made at the Museum as a start for a 'Remembrance' display. Pupils could bring in items from home (photos, letters, small items) which help them remember an event or person
- Pupils could write a letter to someone (real or fictional) explaining the ways that they are remembered
