

Access Terms and Conditions: First World War Flying Machines

- You must be physically able to climb a number of steps up to the aircraft and vehicles. This also requires using your arms to support some of your body weight.
- Please wear sensible clothing. Loose fitting clothing and jewellery are not advised and may prevent access to the aircraft.
- Please wear flat shoes with a good grip – no flip-flops or loose sandals.
- You must be over the age of 16 to hold a valid ticket for the event.
- Access to the cockpits will not be allowed, due to the delicate nature of the collection. You will be allowed to view the aircraft or vehicle up close and behind the barrier with the supervision of the Aircraft Access Team.
- Steps to the aircraft will not have handrails, therefore you must be able to climb without assistance.
- You will not be allowed to touch the aircraft, as most of them are made of canvas and wood.

If the Museum feels that it is not safe, or possible, for you to view a cockpit then we reserve the right to refuse access.
