My dear Dad,

Many thanks for the money, which I got yesterday. I did my cross country flight this morning. It was very wonderful. I was told to go to Beaulieu aerodrome, land, get my tanks filled and return. I left this place & made due South by compass. In ten minutes I was at 3000 feet & saw though a bank of clouds a needle sticking up into the sky, which was Salisbury Cathedral steeple, my first landmark. It looked very funny as it was about 5 miles west of me & I could see neither the town nor any other part of the Cathedral owing to clouds. I then turned South — East & in another 5 minutes I saw in front of me a pale misty triangular patch which by map I knew to be Southampton water. I was then about 6000 ft. passing over the new forest. When I got to the top of Southampton Water I was about 8000 feet it was the most wonderful sight.

I saw right down the water & saw the Solent backed by the Isle of Wight in the misty distance. I then turned along the Bournemouth railway & followed it West & then South until I saw a certain shaped pond the other side of which I knew was the 'drome. I landed, this takes a long time from 8000 feet, got filled up & returned. There were a lot of ships in Southampton Water but as they looked only specks I don't know what they were. I went 45 miles & it took me 35 minutes going & 40 coming back.

I find that this height causes my head to ache a little on landing.



I hope your day in bed has done you good & that it is not as cold at home as it is here. We had a fall of snow a few days ago & the countryside is all white, except the New forest.

I must stop now as it waxeth late.
