Thank you for signing up to run the 2019 RAF Museum's Spitfire 10K. For those of you registering for the first time - welcome! You are now part of a fabulous group of people who are joining together to help raise funds for the Royal Air Force Museum.

The races will take place on the 31 August in London and the 1 September in Cosford, and will take you on a special aviation journey. In London, you will run underneath our Short Sunderland flying boat and in Cosford you will run past several iconic aircraft, before entering the RAF Cosford airfield.

The Spitfire 10K is held to commemorate the Battle of Britain and all the men and women who defended Britain's skies during the summer of 1940. This is why all our runners wear the name of a Battle of Britain pilot with their race number so that we may share further the story of those Royal Air Force personnel who served in this pivotal aerial campaign with a new generation.

## giftaid it

Gift Aid is a scheme set up to enable charities to claim back the income tax you have already paid on donations, meaning that for every £1 donated the charity can claim an additional 25p at no cost to you. Encourage all of your supporters to Gift Aid their donations if they can.

#### Company matching giving

Many companies will match their employee's fundraising efforts, either fully or up to an agreed level. Ask your HR department for more information about how your company can support your fundraising efforts.
