Access Terms and Conditions

- You must be physically able to climb a number of steps up to the aircraft and vehicles and on occasions be able to climb into the cockpit or cab. This also requires using your arms to support some of your body weight.
- Please wear sensible clothing. Loose fitting clothing and jewellery are not advised and may prevent access to the aircraft. Trousers rather than a skirt would also be advisable.
- Please wear flat shoes with a good grip – no flip-flops or loose sandals.
- You are more than welcome to take pictures but please come with a camera that can be zipped into a pocket or one with a strap.
- Minimum height restrictions of 1.07 metres will apply for the event.
- You must be over the age of 12 to hold a valid ticket for the events. However there will be certain aircraft that will require you to be a minimum age of 16 to enter, these will be clearly stated on the website.

If the Museum feels that it is not safe, or possible, for you to access a cockpit then we reserve the right to refuse access.
