FAQs

What do I need to bring?

- A sleeping bag and a pillow
- Roll matt – no blow-up mattresses will be allowed
- PJs or appropriate sleepwear
- We advise that you bring a reusable water bottle, a torch and slippers.
- You will have to move between the Hangars for the different activities so we advise you to bring a jumper to keep warm.

What food and drink will be provided?

- Dinner on arrival
- Midnight snacks
- Hot breakfast
- Tea and coffee throughout the event
- Glass of wine or bottle of beer on arrival
- Cash bar will be available until 1.00am

How do I get to the Museum?

By Road: We're just 10 minutes from Junction 4 of the M1, please use the SATNAV postcode **NW9 5QW**

By Underground: We are situated 30 minutes from Central London at Colindale Underground station which is on the Edgware branch of the Northern Line. At Colindale Underground you can then take an 8 minute bus ride to the Museum - or if you prefer a brisk 12 minute walk.

By Rail: Mill Hill Broadway is the nearest rail station, from here please take the 303 Bus to the Museum, or alternatively, the Museum is a 25 minute walk.

Parking is included in your ticket

Where will I sleep?

You will sleep in the exhibitions in H1 under the aircraft and surrounded by missiles, boats and helicopters. There will be access to toilets and changing facilities.

Can I smoke?

There will be spaces outside where you will be able to smoke.

Can we come as a group?

Yes, but we ask that you are considerate towards the other ticket holders. Any behaviour that disrupts the event may lead to you being asked to leave.

Can I bring children?

No, this is an over 18's event only.

Can I have a refund?

The RAF Museum will not refund a ticket after it has been purchased.

Will the shop be open?

The shop will be open until 8.30pm and will reopen at 9.00am for ticket holders

Can I bring my own booze?

No, there are catering outlets on site that will enable you to purchase alcohol.

I have a food allergy, what should I do?

Please inform us upon booking. We will try to accommodate as much as we possibly can.

Can I bring a blow-up mattress?

No, please bring a roll matt.

Where should I go when I arrive?

When you arrive please make your way to the main entrance at H1. You will be checked in by a member of staff, your bag will be checked for security reasons and then you will be given a programme for the evening and shown where you will be sleeping.

What should I wear?

Flight suits and spitfire pyjamas will be most welcome. Please note that you will have to walk between the Hangars to reach the activities. The open cockpit experience will require you to wear sensible flat shoes (no flip flops or high heels).

Is parking free for ticketholders?

Yes, just park and head straight into the Museum
