

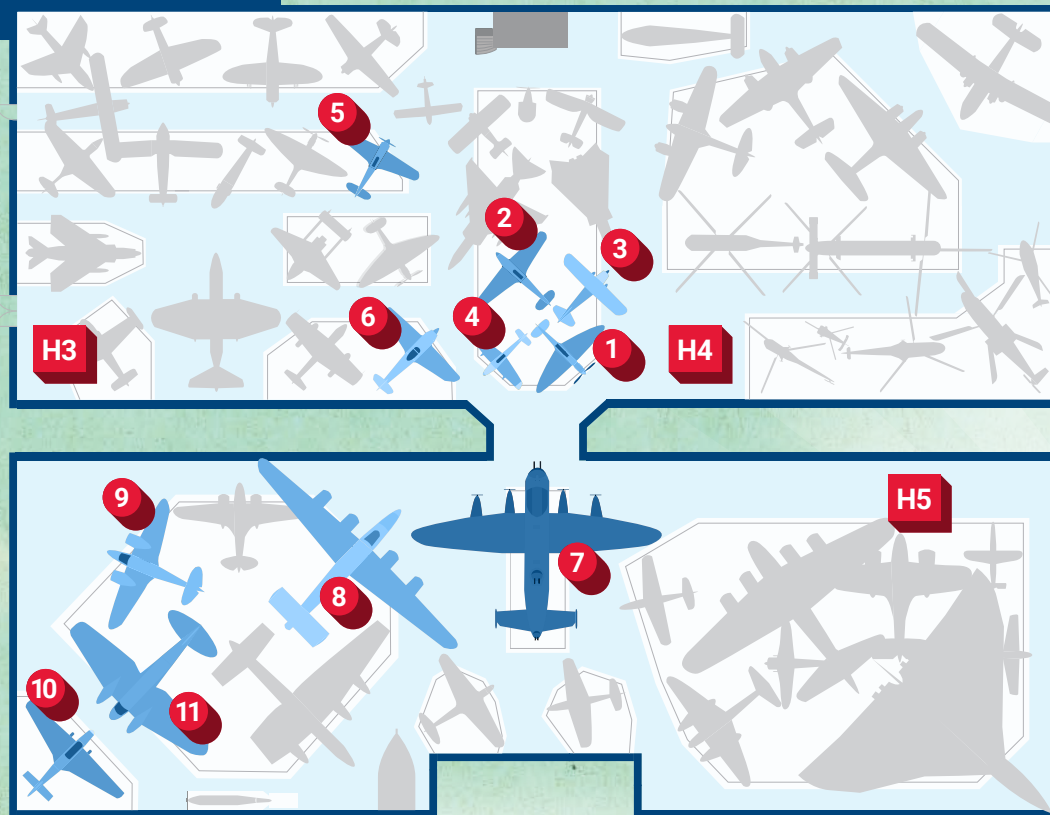
BATTLE OF BRITAIN AT NIGHT
