

100 OPEN COCKPITS AND CABS

Details about the aircraft open on Saturday 8 December for 100 Open Cockpits and Cabs.

Hurricane

This will be view only, but panels will be removed from the side of the aircraft and steps places alongside to see inside the cockpit

Hawker Typhoon

Close view only, there will be steps to enable you to see inside the cockpit

B24 Liberator

Access to bomb bay and the rear fuselage, whilst keeping your feet on the ground.

Gazelle

You will be able to sit in the pilot's seat of this helicopter

Seaplane Tender (ST) 206*

You will be able to climb on board the boat

K2 Ambulance

You will be able to sit in the driver's seat under supervision.

Hoverfly

This is view only, due to the delicate nature of this very early helicopter

North American TB-25 N aka. The Michell Bomber

The rear ventral door will be open, so you can view with feed on ground.

Bristol Beaufort

Steps will be places to enable you to have a better view inside the cockpit.

Trojan

You will be able to sit in the driver's seat of this vehicle.

Queen Mary Cab

You will be able to sit in the driver's seat of this vehicle.

National Fire Service Austin K2

You will be able to sit in the driver's seat of this vehicle.

Stuka Bomber

Steps will be places to enable you to have a high view inside the cockpit.

Hudson

Rear door open with a view up the fuselage of the aircraft
