FAQs

What do I need to bring?

- A sleeping bag and a pillow
- Roll matt no blow up mattresses will be allowed
- PJs or appropriate sleepwear
- We advise that you bring a reusable water bottle, a torch and slippers.
- You will have to move between the Hangars for the different activities so we advise you bring a jumper to keep warm.

What food and drink will be provided?

- Buffet dinner on arrival
- Midnight snacks
- Hot breakfast
- Free tea and coffee throughout the event
- Free drink on arrival
- Cash bar will be available until 1am





How do I get to the Museum?

We're just 10 minutes from Junction 4 of the M1, 30 minutes from Central London by Tube, and a 8 minute bus ride from Colindale Underground Station - or if you prefer a brisk 12 minute walk from Colindale Station.

If you are travelling to us from Mill Hill Broadway Station, please take the 303 Bus from Mill Hill Broadway to Colindale. Alternatively, the Museum is a 25 minute walk from Mill Hill Broadway Station.

- If you are driving by car please use the SATNAV postcode: **NW9 5QW**
- Parking is included in your ticket

Where will I sleep?

You will sleep in the main hall inside Hangar 1, there are access to toilets and changing facilitates.

Can I smoke?

There will be spaces outside where you will be able to smoke.

Can we come as a group?

Yes, but we ask that you are considerate towards the other ticket holders. Any behaviour that disrupts the event may lead to you being asked to leave.

Can I bring children?

No, this is an over 18's event only.

Can I have a refund?

The RAF Museum will not refund a ticket after it has been purchased.

Will the shop be open?

The shop will be open until 9pm and will reopen at 7am

Can I bring my own booze?

No, there are catering outlets on site that will enable you to purchase alcohol.





Can I bring a blow-up mattress?

No, please bring a roll matt.

Where should I go when I arrive?

When you arrive please make your way to the main entrance. You will be checked in by a member of staff, your bag will be checked for secutiry reasons and then you will be given a programme for the evening and shown where you will be sleeping.

What should I wear?

Flight suits and spitfire pyjamas will be most welcome. Please note that you will have to walk between the Hangars to reach the activities. The open cockpit experience will require you to wear sensible flat shoes (no flip flops).

Is parking free for ticketholders?

Yes, just park and head straight into the Museum
