Girlguiding Shropshire launch new challenge badge at Cosford

On Saturday 28 March, over 400 girls and leaders from Rainbow and Brownie groups across Shropshire took part in an event held at the Royal Air Force Museum Cosford to launch their brand new Fun 'n' Flight challenge badge. The badge which explores the wonders of flight through science, art and craft, whilst having fun at the same time will be available to all Girl Guide groups from May.

During the launch event, Rainbows (aged 5-7 years) and Brownies (aged 7-10 years) participated in nine fun and informative activities across the Museum site, to give them all the skills and information needed to successfully obtain their new badge.

Rainbows learnt all about the War as they stepped back in time to take part in a World War Two themed school lesson before taking part in a role play session in the Museum's Lets Fly mock airport, taking on the role of passport control, customs and cabin crew.

Brownies were improving on their science skills as they worked together to build rockets cars before racing them across the hangar. Creative flying themed craft activities were enjoyed by all the youngsters, including; decorating and flying gliders; making mini bi planes using wooden pegs and lollypop sticks; and building rocket wands using card, crepe paper streamers and coloured sticks.

Girls explored the Museum's interactive area Fun 'n' Flight - packed with hands on excitement; it's the easy way to answer all those questions about how aircraft stay up in the air, before rounding off their visit with a ride on the Museums 4D Experience. A fun feature of the day was the chance to dress up in RAF uniforms and wartime clothing and pose for a photo in the selfie pod – a fun and fitting momento of the day.

But it wasn't just fun and games for the youngsters, as part of their badge they must successfully complete their workbook as they wandered around the Museum.
