## Jaguar Primary School Challenge regional final heads to Cosford

**Date:** 21 April 2015 **Time:** 9.00am to 4.00pm



The Staffordshire regional final of the 'F1 in Schools – Jaguar Primary Schools 2D Challenge 2015' will take place at the Royal Air Force Museum Cosford on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> April.

The Jaguar Primary Schools Challenge engages with primary school students and teachers across the UK with over 15,000 students taking part nationally. Teams must project manage, design and manufacture a racing car, emulating the design and engineering processes employed by real engineering companies, such as Jaguar Cars.

During the competition, students learn about a range of science and engineering subjects such as design, manufacture and aerodynamics. Each team works with a Jaguar Land Rover STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) ambassador who mentors them throughout the process.

The F1 – Jaguar Primary Schools Challenge offers students the opportunity to:

- Take part in a fun hands-on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Maths) activity.
- Tackle real life problem solving and learning.
- Develop design, manufacturing, team work, communication & business skills.
- Win a VIP experience at Jaguar Land Rover plus other awards & prizes for their school.
- Teachers gain professional accreditation through the College of Teachers.
- Take part in a UK Nationwide challenge.

Teams of children aged 5-11 taking part in the 2D challenge have been busy designing their racing car made from card, complete with wheels and body, ready to compete in the regional finals this week. Before

the race begins, teams will have time to test their vehicles and make any last minute modifications, before racing head-to-head against teams from other schools. The winning school will then go on to be part of the national finals held at the Ricoh Arena, Coventry in the Jaguar Exhibition Hall on 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2015 with 30 race teams competing.

## Philip Clayton, Education Manager at RAF Museum Cosford said:

"It's a pleasure for the RAF Museum to host such a fun and inspiring educational event. Over 60 students will participate and have the chance to race their cars across the hangars on the day. A lot of hard work has gone into the planning and manufacturing of their cars, so it's exciting to see what designs the students come up with - it's going to be difficult for the judges to decide on a winner"

The Jaguar Primary School Challenge is sponsored and supported by Jaguar Cars who have been a supporter of F1 in Schools since its launch in 2000. Jaguar understands the need to encourage and motivate young people to develop key skills needed for companies to be successful in producing award winning vehicles.
