## Schools set to participate in local Olympics

Local school children from across the West Midlands will be taking part in the Olympics 2012 Inspire to Aim Higher event, hosted at the RAF Museum Cosford on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> May. This special event is a collaboration which aims to promote participation, inclusion and competition, whilst highlighting the values of the Olympic and Paralympic movement.

The day will commence with an opening ceremony including music supplied by the RAF Cosford band, a performance from the Idsall School dance group and an introduction to the day's activities.

Schools will be participating in a variety of activities during their visit. One of the key highlights will be a demonstration from the RAF Cosford Field Gun Crew, led by Cdr Mark Smith RN. This sporting tradition sees a team of 18 people racing a gun and limber over a designated course. It takes great mental and physical strength and is concluded with firing of the gun.

"The Olympic event is a unique opportunity for learners to experience a range of sporting activities outside of the school environment.

This is the first time the Museum has been involved in an event of this kind and it is a wonderful opportunity for learners to experience and learn a range of sports first hand."

Other activities planned include Rockets, Athletics, Football, and Archery. The Lilleshall partially sighted cricket team will also be participating.

Participating schools will also be completing an art competition which ties in with the Olympic theme by creating a unique logo. Guest of Honour, Jez Moxey Chief Executive of Wolverhampton Wanderers football club will be judging the children's work on the day and will announce the winner during the closing ceremony.
