This Half Term Leave Them All At Sea!

26th to 29th of May - Search and Rescue Half Term Week. FREE

This Half Term, the Royal Air Force Museum Cosford invites all children over 5 to join in a free and exciting activity in which both they and their friends will become active participants in an air sea rescue and discover how the Royal Air Force mounts such operations in hazardous conditions.

In each session children will be able to experience what it is really like to be marooned in a life raft and will learn various survival techniques, in the raft, with their fellow crew members.

Sessions are at 11:00, 12:00, 14:00 and 15:00 each day and last approximately 30 minutes. All that we ask is that you report to the Admissions Desk, located in the Visitor Centre, 10 minutes before each session to avoid disappointment, maximum of 20 participants in each session.

Please note, younger children will need to be accompanied by an adult but are welcome to participate in this experience.
